Competitions till 400m are handled on a first-come-first-served basis (date of registration will be decisive). 1 heat for 800m and 1500m men is carried out, 2 heats for 800m ladies. Mixed relays:	<p>Mixed relays are carried out by FINA rules. Groups of 3 women and 1 man are also allowed. The names of swimmers for each group and the distribution of the disciplines are freely selectable and must be stated in the registration. Modifications are accepted until Thursday, 21 June 2018, 20:00.</p>
Ceremonies:	<p>The swimmers are obliged to present themselves on time and in their team wear.</p>
Awards:	<p>Individual and mixed relays places 1 – 3 medals Team classification places 1 – 3 cups Sponsoring relay places 1 - trophy</p>
Luck runs:	<p>The fastest swimmer of a luck run will get a prize. Luck runs will be announced shortly before the start.</p>

Directions to the competition area

**KSS Schaffhausen
Breitenaustrasse 117
8200 Schaffhausen**

General direction:

Keep following direction towards Bahnhof/Breite (the pool is situated in the 'Breite' area). Look out for the signposting.

Approach by bus leaving from SBB railway station Schaffhausen

Bus no. 3, stop Weinberg

Go back a few meters, turn left into Breitenaustrasse.

Pass the ice skating hall. Crossing the parking area you reach the main entrance to the pool.

or

Bus no. 6, stop Hallenbad

Cross the road, take the direction to the school building Breite and turn to the right into the Spielstrasse.

On the left side you'll find the pool.

Arriving by car from Zurich/Winterthur:

In the Cholfirst tunnel take the exit Schaffhausen Süd.

On the Rhine bridge, turn right, direction Kreuzlingen, stay on the left lane.

At the traffic light on the crossroad (after the power station): turn left, direction Bahnhof/Breite.

At the roundabout: 3rd exit, direction to Breite.

At the roundabout: 1st exit (pay attention to the bus stop on the right side), and turn immediately to your left.

Follow the signposting.

Arriving by car from Kreuzlingen/Frauenfeld:

On the Rhine bridge, turn left, direction Zürich/motorway, stay on the left lane.

Traffic light no. 1: straight ahead direction Zürich/motorway.

Traffic light no. 2: straight ahead direction Zürich/motorway, stay on the right lane.

Traffic light no. 3: turn right direction Bahnhof/Breite.

Roundabout: 3rd exit direction to Breite.

Roundabout: 1st exit (pay attention to the bus stop on the right side), and turn immediately to your left.

Follow the signposting.

Arriving by car from Thayngen/Germany:

In the Fäsenstaub tunnel, take exit Schaffhausen Süd/Rheinfall, left lane.

Traffic light no. 1: turn to the left, direction Kreuzlingen, stay on the left lane.

Traffic light no. 2: straight on, direction Kreuzlingen, stay on the left lane.

Traffic light no. 3: roadcross (after power station), turn left, direction Bahnhof/Breite.

Roundabout: 3rd exit, direction to Breite.

Roundabout: 1st exit (pay attention to the bus stop on the right side) and turn immediately to your left.

Follow the signposting.
